#### Supporting one of our own

Some of you may remember Maia, who is a previous Ashhurst School student. Unfortunately, after leaving Ashhurst School and moving on to high school, Maia became very unwell. Over the last almost 4 years, her health has deteriorated significantly. At the end of 2023, Maia finally got a diagnosis of Hypermobile Ehlers-Danlos Syndrome and multiple Abdominal Vascular Compression Syndromes, and the family has been advised by her specialists that surgery is necessary. Unfortunately, there are currently no treatment or surgery options available in Aotearoa for Maia, and travelling to Germany for surgery is our best and most cost-effective option. It does still come with a significant cost. Without fundraising to cover the costs, Maia will not be able to get this surgery, so the family has created a Givealittle page to try to raise enough to give Maia a chance at everyday life.


